WHAT IS THE POSITIVE SCHOOL DISCIPLINE INSTITUTE?

The Positive School Discipline Institute (PSDI) uses a national best practice model, *The Trauma-Informed School*, to implement culturally-responsive, trauma-informed practices in participant schools to transform disciplinary practices. PSDI is a year-long training initiative for schools with a Master Trainer Program (MTP) embedded to reform disciplinary practices and promote student academic success. Our MTP supports a School Trauma Lead Coach for School Teams, who receives additional training and online materials to help a school sustain the work they begin in the first year with the PSDI Initiative.

There are 4 Tracks offered in 2024-2025 which include multiple training options for School Teams, Future Educators, Future Support Staff, Educators and School Personnel, Community and Families.
